A grievance box is placed in the girls' waiting rooms, where students can drop their complaints, if any. The box is opened once a month for review. Any grievances found are scrutinized, and necessary actions are promptly taken by the cell. In case of emergencies, the principal convenes a meeting to address the problems immediately. Over the past two years, the cell has been effectively resolving grievances raised by female students, and the issues have been settled amicably.




